

# The Rest House Poulton Hill, Marlborough, Wiltshire

Approximately 12 miles to Swindon, 17 miles to Newbury, 9 miles to Hungerford, 22 miles to Salisbury, 9 miles yo Junction 15(M4), Pewsey, Great Bedwyn and Swindon stations link with London Paddington about 1 hour

A highly individual 18th Century house, immaculately presented occupying landscaped grounds within walking distance of the High Street.

- Entrance hall Sitting room Kitchen/dining room Pantry Summer room Master bedroom with ensuite bathroom

#### Situation

Marlborough is a thriving and expanding market town with excellent local shopping including some of the major retailers. National retailers include Waitrose supermarket and several quality restaurants including Coles, Godots, Pizza Express, ASK, Costa Coffee and Café Uno. In addition there are the shopping areas in Hilliers Yard (near Waitrose) and Hughenden Yard (between Boots and W H Smith). The extended leisure centre and golf club provide excellent sporting facilities too. Although self-sufficient, the town is well placed for other centres including Swindon, Bath, Hungerford and Newbury and is surrounded by the most attractive countryside of the Marlborough Downs, Pewsey Vale and Kennet Valley. Intercity (Paddington) rail and M4 connections are at both Swindon and Hungerford.

#### Description

The Rest House is thought to date back to 1730 with attractive brick elevations relieved by wooden double glazed windows under a tiled roof. The accommodation, which has been completely refurbished, provides spacious dual aspect rooms.

The house enjoys wonderful rural views of the watermeadows and the Savernake Forest.

The property and the accommodation is particularly well presented with elegant rooms, keeping much charm throughout. The Rest House is located down a small shared private drive. The attractive gardens are mainly laid to lawn with well stocked shrub and flower borders. The garden is about a third of an acre.

#### General remarks

Measurements are given in metres (accurate to 0.1m) followed by feet and inches. Land measurements are to within 5%.
